As India has started to relax some lockdown restrictions, many experts are discussing the impact of the COVID-19 virus and containment measures on the most vulnerable groups in India, and explore the social policy measures and employment opportunities that can protect informal and migrant workers from hunger and extreme poverty. This webinar will look into problems and challenges of Inter-State migrant workers and different aspects of governance to suggest possible long-term policies that can address the problems faced by migrant workers in a post-COVID-19 world.

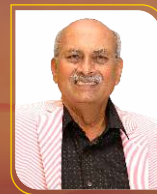
