About ITEP:

ITEP at Lingaraj College:

The Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP), launched by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), is a comprehensive four-year undergraduate course aimed at preparing skilled and well-trained teachers. The Programme seeks to improve the standard of teacher education and equip future educators to effectively handle elementary and/or secondary classrooms, fostering a new generation of quality learners.

Lingaraj College has submitted a proposal to the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) for the introduction of the Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) – B.A. B.Ed. – from the academic session 2026–27. The college has already received the Letter of Intent (LOI) from the NCTE, and all necessary formalities for the appointment of full-time faculty and staff have been completed. The State Government has granted the required permission, and Rani Channamma University, Belagavi, has also issued a No Objection Certificate (NOC) for the Programme

This B.A. B.Ed. Programme is a dual-degree course aligned with the revised National Education Policy (NEP) 2024. Students who have completed their Higher Secondary (Class XII) examinations are eligible to enroll in this four-year integrated course. Upon successful completion, graduates will be qualified as well-trained teachers with multidisciplinary knowledge and experience gained through this Programme

The college proudly adheres to the guidelines set by the Department of Higher Education, Government of Karnataka, and the University Grants Commission (UGC). It is governed by a distinguished Governing Body appointed by the Government of Karnataka, ensuring effective administration and visionary leadership. This governance supports an environment that fosters academic excellence and strategic growth. In accordance with NCTE regulations and as endorsed by the State Government, the Programme will be offered on a not-for-profit basis.

Intake Capacity: This College has submitted its application to start a unit of four-year Integrated B.A.-B.Ed. Programme, with an intake capacity of 50 students in this Programme

Eligibility for Admission into ITEP Program: For admission into the Integrated B.A.-B.Ed. $\,p$ Programme, candidates must meet the following criteria:

- a) Candidates with minimum fifty percent (50%) marks in Senior Secondary or plus two examination or its equivalent from a recognized board.
- b) The relaxation in percentage of marks in the Senior Secondary or plus two examination or its equivalent examination and in the reservation for Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe or Other Backward Class or Persons with Disabilities or Economically Weaker Section and any other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government or State Government, wherever applicable.
- c) The relaxation in percentage of marks in the Senior Secondary or plus two examination or its equivalent examination and in the reservation for Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe or Other Backward Class or Persons with Disabilities or Economically Weaker Section and any other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government or State Government, wherever applicable.

Admission Procedure:

Admission

- a) Admission to the ITEP program will be based on a subject-specific and aptitude test conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA), designed to accommodate the linguistic and cultural diversity of the country.
- b) A single nationwide entrance examination, known as the National Common Entrance Test (NCET), will be conducted by NTA for admission to the four-year ITEP, as recommended under the revised NEP 2024.
- c) The examination will be conducted online in a Computer-Based Test (CBT) format, offered in multiple languages. The test score will reflect the candidate's relative performance and will be used for merit-based selection.
- d) The NTA will prepare a scorecard for each candidate, and admissions will be carried out through a centralized online counselling process.
- e) At the time of admission, candidates must indicate their chosen subject/discipline (B.A. B.Ed.).
- f) Any change in the selected subjects may be made within one month from the commencement of the program.

Admission Fees:

The fee structure is to be determined in accordance with the guidelines provided by the state government, ensuring that it remains affordable and accessible to all eligible students and shall not charge any donations, capitation fee etc. from the students.
